Topic: Science (45 mins)

Today we are continuing to find out about different groups of animals- amphibians, birds and repeating reptiles as well (as they are quite similar to amphibians). Then, watch it again and perhaps pause it after each fact and say that fact out loud to help you remember it. After you have watched each video there is a little game you can play as well as a quiz.

Phonics (25 mins)

Choose from the first 3 games (which are free), and then choose the relevant phase and sound for your child's group:

Group 1- phase 3, sound 'th'

Group 2- phase 4, CVCC set 1-7 plus digraphs

Group 3- phase 5, sound 'ea'

Group 4 - phase 2, set 1 & 2 plus set 3 (g)

Please practise sounding out and blending real and nonsense words using this sound. When you are confident, can you then think of 3-5 words using this sound and write them down? (*For phase 4, please use the phase 3 sound*).

For group 4 - Now, can you write the sound 5 times? Can you think of a word with these sounds in? Can you write the word using your phonics?

Reading (10 mins)

Please continue to read regularly each day with your child and enjoy sharing a variety of texts, e.g. stories, non-fiction books, poems etc. From next week, we will be sending out individual login details to give you access to e-books that match your child's current reading levels.
