Our site oldfield-brow.com uses cookies in order for the site to work properly, both on it's own, and with third party providers, such as Twitter and Google.

A cookie is a small piece of data stored on your computer by your web browser, that allows a website to recognise a user's device.

The use of cookies is widespread across the internet.

Cookies allow our site (oldfield-brow.com) to respond to requests, and to recognise a user's device when performing an operation (such as downloading a file or sending an enquiry.) Cookies also allow staff to be authenticated when logging into the website.

We also use the web tracking service Google Analytics, which reads and writes cookies in order to help us understand the traffic patterns to our website. This provides anonymous information i.e. statistics on user totals rather than individually identifiable data.

Whilst Google Analytics helps us understand trends and patterns, it does not allow site visitors to be individually identified.
