



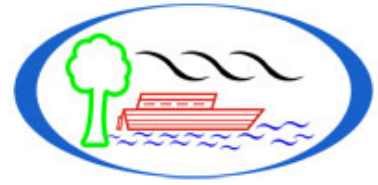
Reading in Nursery:
