Please try to help us by packing snacks separately from your child's lunch so that can be stored in their tray for easy access at breaktime.

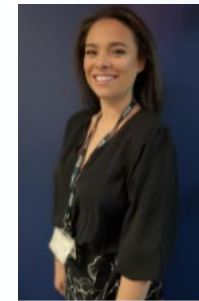

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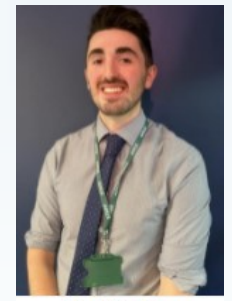

We are very excited to welcome your wonderful children to Year 4. We hope to share some important information with you in this document.

Chatterday:

We will be sending home this half-terms 'Chatterday' work. Children can choose one (or more!) of the three options to complete each week. Once complete, children can bring their work in to school for it to be displayed. Some of the most fantastic work may also feature on our website or Twitter!

Spellings:

Children will be set their spellings on Spelling Shed every Friday to practise for a test the following Friday. They will need to login to EdShed using the same details from last year to practise their spellings each week. The children also have a spelling journal which they can take home to practise their weekly spellings in and they should bring this back in to school each Friday. Please contact your class teacher if you need your login details.

Timestables

In Year 4 the children will undertake the Multiplication Timestable Check (MTC). It is extremely important that children practise their timestables regularly on TTRS to consolidate their understanding. We will be setting sessions on TTRS for the children to complete each week. Each child will also receive a Timestable Booklet for them to practise their timestables in too. We will send out the children's login details again.

Things you will need in Year 4

Swimming

Year 4 children will be going swimming every **Thursday starting next week! (16th September)**. Therefore, a swimming kit will be needed each Thursday for the first term!

A towel and swimwear are essential. Goggles and a swim hat can be brought too.

PE Kit

For indoor PE, black shorts, a t-shirt in your child's house colour (red, blue, green, yellow) and black pumps will be needed.

For outside, trainers, black trousers and a warm black jacket/jumper will be needed in addition to your house t-shirt. **Our PE lessons are on Tuesdays and Thursdays.**

Reading Book/ Reading Record

It is essential that your child brings these items in everyday and that they are taken home every afternoon. We have a wonderful library for the children to choose a reading book from each week. Please encourage your child to read each day and make a note of this in their Reading Record for your child's class teacher to see.
